

BROMLEY 24/7 OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

MECHANISM 95:



SEAT-HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT:

To raise the seat, take the weight off the seat, turn the right lever **1** upwards, let go of the lever when the seat is at the desired height.

To lower the seat, put your weight on the seat, turn the lever downwards, let go when the seat is in the desired position.



SEAT SLIDE ADJUSTMENT:

Turn the lever **5** upwards, hold the lever and slide the seat into the desired position. To lock the seat release the lever.

To return the seat automatically to its original position, take the weight of the seat and turn the lever upwards.




INCREASE BACKREST COUNTER PRESSURE, SIDE TENSION:

To increase backrest counter pressure turn the hand wheel **4** clockwise, to reduce backrest counter pressure turn hand wheel anti-clockwise.



EASY TOUCH HEIGHT ADJUSTABLE BACKREST:

Using both hands, from a seated position raise the backrest step by step into the desired position. To lower the backrest, raise it to the highest position, lower it completely and then raise again step by step, if desired.



PUSH BUTTON TOUCH HEIGHT ADJUSTABLE BACKREST:

Adjustment of armrest A15 - Adjust height of arm by pressing button in and lifting armrest step by step to the desired height.

SYNCHRONISED MOVEMENT:

To activate the synchronised movement, press the right button **2/3** and apply pressure to the backrest. To lock the synchronised movement (5 positions), press the button **2/3** again when the backrest is at the desired position.

FORWARD TILT/PERMANENT CONTACT:

Ensure that synchronised movement **2/3** is activated, press the left button **6** and apply pressure to the back rest.

To lock the back rest tilt (5 positions) press the button **6** again when the back rest is in the desired position.

GUARANTEE:

Axiom 24/7 seating programme is covered by a comprehensive five year guarantee that includes all parts and standard fabrics.

For twenty-four hour use, the range is guaranteed for a period of 24 months.
